#### **4.) Officials, Accomodation, Meals**

Mozart Cup 2010 will be held according to ISU General Regulations 2008, the special regulations Synchronized Skating 2008 as well as the valid technical Regulations an Conditions SYS 2009 of the Austrian Figure Skating Association.

The ISU judging system will be used.

#### **Officials:**

##### Panel:

The technical panel / Judges in each category will consist of:

1 Referee, 1 Assistent Referee Ice, 3 – 5 Judges

1 Technical Controller, 1 Technical Specialist, 1 Assistent Technical Specialist

##### Judges:

Judges qualified to judge nationally or judges, which are on the ISU list as judges eligible for international competitions or ISU Championships, can be entered by their respective federation or club.

The organizing club will pay for meals and accommodation from the evening of Friday, January 15th until the evening of Sunday, January 17th.

All further costs (such as travelling expenses) are the responsibility of the officials, or their federation or club, by which they were entered.

##### Judges meeting:

The first judges meeting for the competition will be held on Saturday, January 16<sup>th</sup> at around 2 pm at the rink.

The “Round Table Discussion“ will be held on Sunday, January 17th at the rink.
